



**4.03** **Ready-to-Feed Infant Formula**

**B. Documentation**

The Competent Professional Authority (CPA) must document the need for the ready-to-feed infant formula in the participant's Care Plan.

**C. Formula Changes**

All ready-to-feed formula changes are to be done by the Competent Professional Authority (CPA). Only a Competent Professional Authority (CPA) is authorized to prescribe supplemental foods in quantities that do not exceed the regulatory maximum and are appropriate for the participant, taking into consideration the participant's age and nutritional needs.

**D. Damaged or Out-of-Date Ready-to-Feed Formula**

Cans of ready-to-feed formula located in the clinics that are damaged or out-of-date must be discarded/destroyed. Labels from the out-of-date or damaged cans should first be removed and destroyed.
